

How To Use EBT Card Online to Receive Grocery Delivery

CalFresh provides monthly food benefits that can assist individuals and families to buy healthy and nutritious food. Even temporarily, individuals and families who have experienced a change in their circumstances and need additional help can apply for CalFresh.

Individuals and families can purchase groceries online using their CalFresh food benefits. CalFresh recipients can use their Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card to purchase groceries online at participating stores. You will be able to order food online and select home delivery or pick up options at participating locations.



Frequently Asked Questions

Can I use my EBT card to make purchases online?

Yes, you can purchase the same food you would normally purchase in-store online at participating retailers.

Is there a delivery fee?

Yes, the delivery fee depends on the retailer and size of the order.

CalFresh Food benefits cannot be used to cover the cost of delivery.
