



NOTICE OF MODERNIZING THE OLDER CALIFORNIANS ACT (MOCA) NUTRITION FUNDING AVAILABLE – INVITATION FOR BID/REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL 07/13/2026

As required, Sourcewise will conduct a competitive procurement process through a Request for Proposal (RFP) for innovative and expanded services under the Modernizing the Older Californians Act (MOCA) for programs receiving an aggregate funding allocation of more than \$100,000.

Sourcewise is announcing the availability of funding for the Brown Bag Program, Groceries Program, and Home-Delivered Meal nutrition services. Funding will support the administration of selected programs under the Older Americans Act (OAA) and the Modernizing the Older Californians Act (MOCA) during the contract period of **October 1, 2026, through March 31, 2027**, for the following services:

The total amount of funding available in Modernizing the Older Californians Act Nutrition RFP is **\$357,691**.

All interested applicants, whether public, private, non-profit, or profit-making agencies are eligible organizations. Contract awards made to for-profit organizations must be approved by the California Department of Aging. All recipients of funds that are private agencies must be incorporated in order to safeguard the interests of the California Department of Aging and Sourcewise. Private individuals are not eligible to apply for this grant.

Department of Aging. All recipients of funds that are private agencies must be incorporated in order to safeguard the interests of the California Department of Aging and Sourcewise.

Letter of Intent:

The Letter of Intent must be submitted electronically by the bidder to Shirley Chang Le at scle@mysourcewise.com no later than **Thursday, July 23, 2026, by 4:00pm**.

The authorized signature is acceptable in two formats: (1) ink signature and scanned or (2) signed electronically using DocuSign or Adobe Acrobat with authentic digital signature. Submit the completed and signed Letter of Intent to scle@mysourcewise.com

All bidders are required to submit a fully completed Letter of Intent. Partial submissions or alternative formats will not be accepted.

Proposal Due Date:

Complete paper & electronic proposals must be submitted to Sourcewise or they will not be considered for funding on **Tuesday, August 11, 2026 by 4:00 pm**. The below submissions are required:

Funding Availability:

Proposals must be limited to the amount of funds that correspond to the specific program(s) available in the MOCA RFP as stated. Each of the allocations represents a planning estimate provided by the California Department of Aging and/or Federal Government and is subject to change. Funding is contingent upon the availability of federal funds, including the Sourcewise planning process.

Contract Period:

The initial contract period is **October 1, 2026 to March 31, 2027**. A contract renewal up to one year following the initial contract period is allowable at the discretion of the Area Agency on Aging (AAA) which is subject to annual renegotiation and availability of federal, state, and local funding. The renewal contract term is from April 1, 2027 to March 31, 2028.
